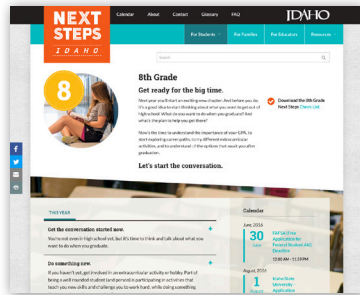
Next Steps Idaho is here to help get every student in the state ready for life beyond high school.

- Explore careers that relate to your interests

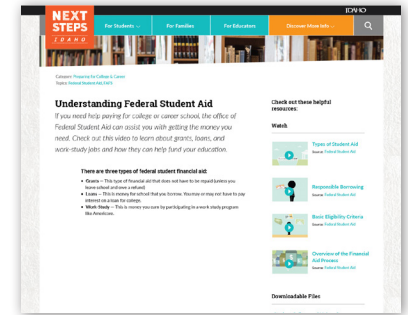
