Deadlines

- Application will remain open through summer- still free to apply
- Enrollment deadline: Extended to June 1 (soft deadline- if students need more time, please reach out to student's admission counselor)

Class Registration

- Upon submitting enrollment deposit, students complete pre-registration questionnaire
 - The College uses this to build first semester schedules
 - If completed later than July 1, class selection becomes much more scarce
