Application for Admission

We are accepting applications for Fall 2020 admission and expect to continue to do so through August 1. Admissions hosts daily virtual information sessions, and students can request a one-on-one virtual appointment with an admissions counselor for more assistance. Good to Know

- There is no decision yet about Fall 2020 course delivery
- We will not require final high school transcripts until fall
- We expect to continue to accept Intent to Enroll beyond June 1
- Pass/no pass final semester grades will have no bearing on a student's offer of admission or scholarships for Fall 2020
- Fall 2020 applicants who now do not have the ACT or SAT scores needed to complete their application may request review without them by contacting Admissions; admissions decisions for these students will be made on a case-by-case basis
- Students deciding to delay enrolling in the fall do not need to reapply; they need to only fill out a Semester Switch form on the Admissions website
- There will be no change to the way we accept AP exam credit for Fall 2020
- We are unable to grant credit for IB exams since those exams were canceled. We will award ENGL 101 credit for completion of the IB diploma.
